WHEREAS, The Kentucky Crossroads Harvest Festival BBQ Competition will be held in Springfield, Kentucky, on October 2-4, 2009, featuring competitors from around the region who will vie for the designation of Kentucky State Barbecue Champion; and

WHEREAS, This event will be a Kansas City Barbeque Society-sanctioned cook-off, and categories will include ribs, chicken, pork, and brisket; and
